2. Five years of extensive mental health or financial practice in areas of expertise relevant to collaborative family law or three years of extensive mental health or financial practice in areas of expertise relevant to collaborative family law and other relevant life experience and/or training as the Board of Directors deems appropriate.

3. Attendance at monthly meetings: a minimum of 4 monthly meetings each calendar year or 2 monthly meetings each calendar year if the member has also participated in two (2) collaborative team cases during each calendar year. A collaborative team case involves at least one (1) allied professional.

4. Training: completion of 14 hour introductory training in collaborative law.

5. Professional liability insurance with policy limits of no less than \$100,000/\$300,000.
